



Permian Highway Pipeline

Project Open House

The Permian Highway Pipeline (PHP) Project will provide an outlet for increased natural gas production from the Permian Basin to growing market areas along the Texas Gulf Coast. The project will traverse 16 counties in Texas, and is designed to transport up to 2.1 billion cubic feet per day (Bcf/d) of natural gas through approximately 430 miles of 42-inch pipeline. It is being proposed by Kinder Morgan Texas Pipeline (KMTP) and EagleClaw Midstream Ventures, and will be built and operated by KMTP.

An open house is being held in Caldwell County to give landowners and the general public the opportunity to learn more about the project and ask questions.
